2023 Humanitarian Aid Grants Announced

At its May 1, 2023, meeting, WELS Christian Aid and Relief approved humanitarian aid grants totaling \$702,390 for FY 23/24. WELS home missions will receive \$43,498 in assistance; \$658,892 will go to support world mission efforts. These are projects developed by WELS home and world missionaries to reflect Christ's compassion to the people of their communities and build relationships that lead to opportunities to share the gospel.

"Seven hundred thousand dollars is a lot of money, but I believe it is money well spent. These dollars assist our missionaries at home and abroad to reach out in compassion to hurting people and help them. That's reason enough for such an investment!" says Rev. Dan Sims, director of WELS Christian Aid and Relief. "But these acts of kindness help to build trusting relationships and lead to many opportunities to share the good
