All members from Morrison Zion and Immanuel Shirley are invited to join us Saturday, March 9 from 9-11am at the Ponderosa in Morrison for a presentation and Q & A with Pastor Joel Gaertner from WELS Congregational Services. This meeting is held offsite since the research and planning for a process like this encourages large meetings like this to be held at a neutral location instead of one of the churches. Pastor Gaertner will present "Exploration – The First Step" and host a Q&A on the following topics:

- a) the challenges facing the American church in this culture and the opportunities that it presents.
 - b) WELS history of starting churches.

Catechism Class

- c) the mission of the Church.
- d) the importance of critical mass in carrying out that mission.
- e) types of mergers/consolidations: absorption, rebranding, multi-site, etc.
- f) the things that can derail a mer-

ger.

g) explanation of the "Merge for Mission" process.

Households/members will take home a "Phase 1 – Exploration discussion guide" for further study. Members will be encouraged to use this study in their homes, and then as a congregation discuss it together and then voters decide if the congregation wants to proceed to phase 2 (of 4 phases).
