Anger Fatique


Aren't you tired? Tired of being offended at the world. Tired of the way you feel towards that person who hurt you years ago. Tired of the anger that the news wants you to have. Tired of the divide and outrage that culture wants to create in people. Tired of being angry at yourself and so many others. Many Christians think it is the right and job to be offended at the evil and sin in the world. But what if there was a different way to live without being so angry and continually offended?

In Ephesians 4-6 Paul speaks extensively on how Christians can live. In 4:26-27 he writes "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold. Ok. So, Paul tells us we can be angry just not sin

when we are angry. This is what many Christians have come to believe about anger. There is good anger and bad anger. Most have been told, it is ok to be angry as long as I'm not sinning. Many have come to believe that anger is good and useful. Some think anger is what gets things done. The thought is, anger brings about change. But is this true? Is it necessary I hold on to my anger, especially if it means I hold grudges and struggle to forgive? Let's keep reading the rest of the chapter to see what Paul is really saying about anger.

²⁹ Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. ³⁰ And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³² Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you (Ephesians 4:29-32).

Consider all the things that Paul says. Can you be angry without having unwholesome talk? Is your anger building up others? And there it is in verse 31. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. The direction is to not sit in anger but to get rid of it. Anger is something we will experience, but the author Brant Hansen in his book Unoffendable ask us to consider that God is the only one who has the right to be angry. Why? Because he is holy and perfect and just. He alone has righteous anger. The rest of us may get angry but do we have the right to be? And if we hold on to it for any extended period we will sin. Hansen's encouragement is to take to heart the words of Ephesians 4:31-32. To get rid of anger and bitterness. Why can we do this? God has forgiven all your sins through Christ. Because of this I can forgive others. I can forgive myself.



But what about justice? Do I just forget what happened? Does the Bible say, "forgive and forget"? No it doesn't. The Bible never says this. God treats forgets our sins because Jesus paid for them. God wants us to forgive one another in Christ, and to let go of hate and anger we towards others. But justice and punishment can still be carried out. But let God carry out his justice or let those in authority help carry it out. Forgiveness doesn't mean ignoring something or not seeking justice, but I may not see justice carried out the way I want it to. I also shouldn't seek justice through all the things I'm told to get rid of in Ephesians 4:31 (bitterness, rage, anger). If you struggle with this all consider the last time your anger helped you do something better. Did your anger help your relationships? Did your anger help you think straight and speak better? In all of this, when we see the love God has for us through Jesus, we can show more love and compassion to others.

Updates from the Leadership Team

June 17, 2025

- Devotion Theme Psalm 66
- We reflected on the comfort and joy found in Psalm 66, and were reminded to praise God for His goodness and the many ways He blesses us.
- The LT discussed planning a Staff and Called Worker Appreciation Sunday to recognize anniversaries and faithful service. There was strong support for moving forward, with the event likely taking place in spring. More details will be shared as plans develop.

Gluten free wafers are also available. Hold your palm down to let the server know you would like the gluten free wafer.

Offering There will be no offering taken during the service. You can place your offerings in the back of the church before or after worship. Each church member has assigned envelopes that can be used at either church. Those envelopes will be returned to the appropriate church. Loose donations put in baskets will remain with the church it was donated to. Direct deposit is also available.

They also run specials and bonuses that you will be notified of only through the app. The credits earned by the purchase of Scrip are split 50/50; one half of the revenue will stay in the Scrip program for expenses and distribution to MZLS and one half will be credited to a family's tuition account.
